

St James' Church Improvements

We are transforming the open space next to St James' Church. Thanks to valuable feedback from the local community, we have created plans to make the space greener, more accessible, and better suited to the needs of residents.

Key improvements include:

- 1** Larger paved space in front of the church
- 2** New footpath to replace existing
- 3** New seating
- 4** Planting including flowering shrubs
- 5** Hedge planting
- 6** Bulb planting to existing grass areas
- 7** New tree planting
- 8** Existing trees retained

Work is due to start in October 2023 and should be completed in the Autumn.

During construction access to the church will be maintained from Popham Street. A path will remain open from Bishop Street and Prebend Street to Popham Street.

The work will be undertaken in phases with the planting being undertaken in late Autumn once the hard landscape is completed.
